1. Buy or make a meal for a foster family
2. Support social workers through our Love on Caseworkers program
3. Invite us to speak to your church, SS class, or Bible Study
4. Host a drive for toiletries (body wash, shampoo, deodorant)
5. Buy a pair of shoes for a teen
6. Buy a pack-n-play or car seat for DFCS to keep on hand
7. Offer your church building for foster parent training or teen event
8. Buy a Bible or devotional for a child or family (English or Spanish)
9. Build-a-Bed using our bunk bed blueprints
10. Join a delivery team to take needed items to foster families
11. Hold a diaper and baby wipes drive
12. Pray for children, foster parents, and biological families
13. Become a foster parent or respite resource
14. Buy a birthday gift for a child or teen
15. Sponsor a hair cut
16. Become a CASA (court appointed special advocate)
17. Invite us to speak to your civic organization or business
18. Buy back-to-school clothes for a child
19. Advocate for Trauma-Informed Classroom training in schools
20. Collect new pajamas for children coming into foster care
21. Pay for sports team fees or sporting goods
22. Buy a \$10 gift card so teens can buy toiletries they like
23. Donate family activities like board games or outside toys
24. Pack a Journey Bag for a child coming into foster care
25. Donate \$10 fast food gift cards so social workers can feed hungry children as they come into foster care
